#### Emmanuel Lutheran Church Annual Meeting January 15, 2023

The Annual meeting of Emmanuel Lutheran Church was called to order at 9:40 a.m. by President Matt Gross with 45 members of the congregation present.

Pastor Broers led the meeting with devotions.

A motion was made to approve the agenda by Rollie Purdy and seconded by Iris Westphal. Motion carried.

Minutes of the semi-annual meeting held July 17, 2022 were read by secretary pro-tem Gini Herr. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Paul Bigelow and seconded by George Feazell and the motion carried.
